

Electrical Lineworker Scholarship Guidelines



Objective:

To encourage, promote, and educate lineworkers for enduring and rewarding careers.

Policy:

I. Availability

Scholarships may be awarded to applicants who plan to attend an approved lineworker training program.

- A. The application deadline is March 1.
- B. The scholarships are available for up to \$7,000.
- C. The scholarships are available to all qualified applicants.

II. Selection Process

- A. Powder River Energy Corporation (PRECorp) will be responsible for providing information to high schools in their general area. PRECorp will be responsible for advertising scholarship application information in local media.
- B. Candidates must submit applications to PRECorp. Email to: coop; or mail to: pRECorp.lineman.coop; or mailto:
- C. Scholarship recipient and alternate will be selected according to the following:
 - 1. Scholarship applications will include an application form, a resume detailing employment experience and duties, specialized skills, and three (3) letters of recommendation.
 - 2. Application deadline is March 1 to be eligible for funds in the current academic year.
 - 3. PRECorp may choose one (1) or more qualified recipients for the scholarship.
 - 4. PRECorp may award an alternate the scholarship if the original applicant selected is unable to use the scholarship.

III. Payment

- A. The first scholarship payment will be made when the student enrolls in the next available session or semester of an approved regional lineworker training program.
- B. The scholarship may be paid in installments based on the number of semesters; and will be paid directly to the student's account at his/her school of choice.
- C. Verification of enrollment and GPA must be sent to PRECorp upon completion of each semester/session and prior to release of additional scholarship funds. If enrollment verification and GPA are not submitted, the funds will not be issued.
- D. No further scholarship money will be awarded in the event the student fails to complete the program or fails to maintain a 2.5 GPA, at which time the student will be asked to repay the scholarship funds previously received.
