Powder River Energy Foundation Mission:

The Mission of the Powder River Energy Foundation (PRECorp Foundation) is to demonstrate our commitment to people and non-profit or charitable organizations in northeast Wyoming by lending a helping hand that will improve their quality of life or serve their community.

For the past 75-plus years, Powder River Energy Corporation (PRECorp) has joined forces with the cooperative's consumer-members to strengthen and enhance the communities in northeast Wyoming.

In 2007, PRECorp established the Powder River Energy Foundation for the sole purpose of supporting the charitable needs of the PRECorp service territory. The charitable needs of the communities became very real in recent months with a series of economic challenges across many of the foundational sectors of our area. Market downturns in the ag and energy industries, shutdowns of economies by the COVID-19 virus pandemic response, and shortages of supplies for those most in need, created urgent needs locally and nationally.

Because of long-term strategic planning, the PRECorp Foundation is in a position to respond to these challenges with direct giving to programs focused on food distribution, workforce development, families in crisis, and student scholarships.

The Foundation Board of Directors is grateful to each and every person, business partner, and sponsor organization who helps the Foundation deliver on its mission.

In 2021, the Foundation fundraising events of the Durham Ranch Buffalo Stampede and the annual Foundation Golf Scramble will be held.

The community pulled together to recover from a difficult 2020. Now is an important time to participate in small-giving opportunities such as Operation RoundUp®. This program has been the bedrock revenue stream for the Foundation since 2007. So far, 14% of PRECorp members participate in the program. We invite more members to sign up and help the cause.

The program is a voluntary option available only to PRECorp consumer-members of any size. You simply round up your monthly bill to the nearest whole dollar, and you automatically send an average of only 50 cents per month per account to the Foundation.

The Foundation provides six seasonal contests where new and existing Operation RoundUp® members are eligible to win a prize of 25 pounds of beef and pork. If you are not signed up, please consider doing so.

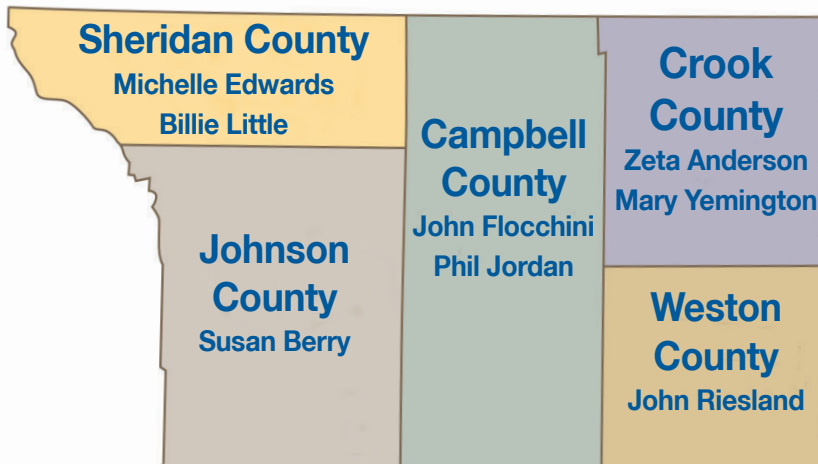
